Lent



Our Lent Preaching Series is entitled 'Living without Limits'. We'll be looking at strengthening, widening and deepening our relationship with Jesus.

Lent marks Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness when he didn't eat but prayed and overcame the devil's temptations. For us, Lent is meant to be a special time of reflection and prayer, and you may also decide to give up something, or fast for periods of time.

Whatever your habits, I encourage you to especially over Lent to take time on your own to be with God; to pray and read your Bible. There are copies of Bible Study notes available in church this month. If you don't already have a regular pattern of bible reading, please take one. Alternatively, download onto your phone an App like "Every Day with Jesus", where you can read or listen to scripture.

I pray that each of us will develop healthy habits to enable us to grow in our faith not only during Lent but the whole year through.
